

# **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA – UNIVERSITY BURSARY PROGRAM- 2017-2018 MERIT BURSARIES**

## **MERIT BURSARIES/INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM SPORTS \***

**Bursary Amount:**

**Bursaries of \$2,000**

*For student-athletes belonging to a university team competing in the RSEQ and/ or USPORTS (one team sports category, one individual sports category).*

### **Objective**

To encourage a student-athlete belonging to a Quebec university team who performed outstandingly during the 2017-2018 season (May 1st, 2017 to April 30th, 2018).

### **Eligibility criteria**

- ◆ To have successfully completed a minimum of 12 credits in one session or a total of 18 credits during the reference year (equivalent volume of study at the Master's or PhD level) in a Quebec university;
- ◆ To be a full-time student in a Quebec university involved in the RSEQ and/or USPORTS in the coming year;
- ◆ To be a member of a university team that is a part of the RSEQ and/or USPORTS in 2018-2019;
- ◆ To have obtained outstanding athletic results during the 2017-2018 season;
- ◆ To have maintained a GPA above 2.3 on 4.3 (or equivalent) during the reference year (May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018);
- ◆ A student-athlete who withdraws from his university team or his academic program is automatically disqualified and loses his bursary without exception.

## **MERIT BURSARIES/ ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**

**Bursary Amount:**

**Bursaries of \$2,000**

*For student-athletes belonging to a university team competing in the RSEQ and/or USPORTS.*

### **Objective**

To encourage a student-athlete belonging to a Quebec university team who has achieved outstanding academic and athletic results during the 2017-2018 season (May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018).

### **Eligibility criteria**

- ◆ To have successfully completed a minimum of 24 credits during the reference year (equivalent volume of study at the Master's or PhD level) in a Quebec university;
- ◆ To be a full-time student in a Quebec university involved in the RSEQ and/or USPORTS in the coming year;
- ◆ To be a member of a university team that is a part of the RSEQ and/or USPORTS in 2018-2019;
- ◆ To have obtained outstanding academic and athletic results during the 2017-2018 season (60% weighting is given to academic results and forty 40% to athletic performance).
- ◆ A student-athlete who withdraws from his university team or his academic program is automatically disqualified and loses his bursary without exception.

*For student-athletes belonging to a university team competing in the RSEQ and/or USPORTS.*

## **Objective**

To encourage a student-athlete belonging to a Quebec university team who distinguished himself (or herself) by their community involvement and by their capacity to assume leadership in their entourage while obtaining good athletic and academic results in the 2017-2018 season (May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018).

## **Eligibility criteria**

- ◆ To have successfully completed a minimum of 12 credits in one session or a total of 18 credits during the reference year (equivalent volume of study at the Master's or PhD level) in a Quebec university;
- ◆ To be a full-time student in a Quebec university involved in the RSEQ and/or USPORTS in the coming year;
- ◆ To be a member of a university team that is a part of the RSEQ and/or USPORTS in 2018-2019;
- ◆ To have obtained good athletic results during the 2017-2018 season;
- ◆ To have maintained a GPA above 2.6 on 4.3 (or equivalent) during the reference year (May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018);
- ◆ Have distinguished himself (or herself) by his involvement within the community;
- ◆ Have demonstrated capacity for leadership, more particularly the ability to lead and to motivate others;
- ◆ A student-athlete who withdraws from his university team or his academic program is automatically disqualified and loses his bursary without exception.
